The Rock Carvings at Fullerton Avenue

This map shows the location of some two dozen rock carvings scattered around the park just south of Theater on the Lake at Fullerton Avenue.

The photo icons indicate locations within several feet. The blue digits show the approximate number of sculpture-bearing blocks when there is more than one block at a particular spot. There are sometimes more carvings in a location than these numbers show since one block can host multiple carvings. Artworks on a single rock are separated by commas in the labels. Works on different rocks are separated with semi-colons.
